Scheduling is flexible and according to the availabilities of the volunteers. The final number of volunteers required and the activities in which they will participate will depend in part on the scale and scope of the conference activities.

Volunteers must be registered delegates of the conference, and partial rebates will be given post-conference based on the amount of time volunteered.

- Volunteers will not be formally placed until their conference registration and fee payment are complete;
- CIP will refund a portion of the student's registration fee based on the number of hours volunteered.
