



CIP President's Award

About the CIP President's Award

Context

CIP established the President's Award in 2006 to recognize achievement by a Canadian individual or organization whose significant contribution to the planning community warrants acknowledgment on a national level.

Recipients of this award are chosen by the current President of the Institute, with endorsement from CIP's Board of Directors. This award does not involve a nomination process.

The award is given annually to an individual or organization by the current President at the CIP national conference.

Eligibility

The recipient(s) may hold membership in CIP, but this is not required.

Nomination Procedure

This award does not involve a nomination process for a recipient, although the President typically invites CIP's Board of Directors to put forward suggested nominees.

Selection Process

The recipient is selected at the discretion of the current President of the Institute.

Approval Process

Selections are submitted for endorsement by the CIP Board of Directors.

Notification of Recipient

Recipient must be identified at **least** 12 weeks prior to start of annual conference.
