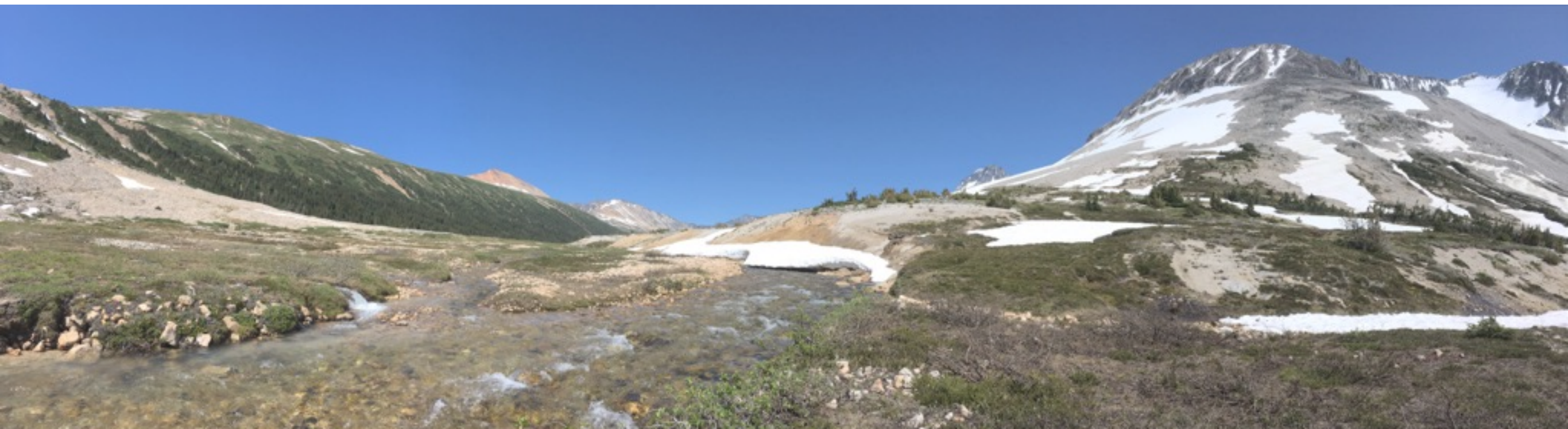










What is the problem?

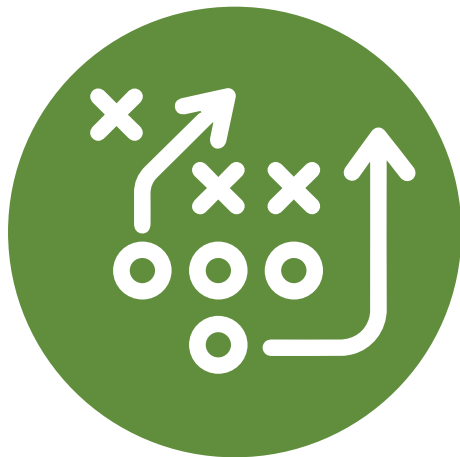
BC Outdoor Recreation Decision-Making Framework

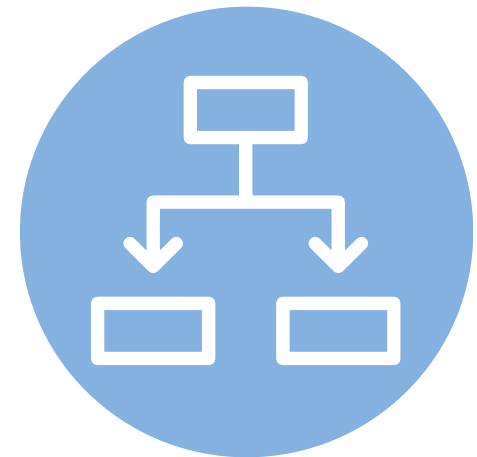
